SASH clinical case challenge


Jerry the dyspnoeic Kelpie



Test yourself with an interactive, multiple-choice case challenge, featuring Jerry, the three-year-old male entire Kelpie who presents with dyspnoea and lethargy. Jerry is up to date with modern tick treatments

He has pale mucous membranes, severe dyspnoea with dull lung sounds bilaterally and a temperature of 39.8 degrees Celsius. He is given oxygen support and you perform the following diagnostics:







- PCV/TP: 38% 48g/L
- Blood gas analysis: mild hypokalaemia and moderate hyperlactataemia
- In-house CBC: moderate neutropenia with suspected bands and moderate monocytosis
- In-house biochemistry: within normal limits
- In-house C-reactive protein: 98.7mg/L
- aFAST: no free fluid found
- tFAST: see left.

Antimicrobial Usage Guide Small Animal Specialist Hospital Antimicrobial Usage Guide

- Microbiology should guide therapy where possible
- Indications should be evidence-based & include a bacterial cause in most instances
- Narrowest spectrum possible
- Dosage appropriate to species, site & type of infection (label not always accurate)
- Minimise duration of therapy
- Ensure monotherapy wherever possible (one drug rather than combinations of drugs)

Green: First choice C&S Idea

New ICU

SASH Central Coast

SASH Central Coast is proud to announce its new ICU, commissioned in June. Under the oversight of Dr Lisa Smart (Emergency & Critical Care Specialist), Dr Cait Hope (ECC Team Lead), and Jen Witt (ECC Nurse Lead), the new ICU enables advanced ICU care to be provided to the pets of the Central Coast and surrounds.



The SASH ICU features:

- · Specialist led service by Dr Lisa Smart BVSc(Hons) DACVECC PhD
- 13 highly experienced career emergency veterinarians, 11 of whom have obtained GradCert in emergency and/or ECC memberships
- · RECOVER CPR certified staff
- · Oxygen cage tower
- · High flow oxygen therapy to reduce the effort needed to breath improving oxygen delivery and thereby the need for intubated ventilation
- · New ventilators to augment existing units
- · Biphasic defibrillator
- · Blood bank for both whole blood and plasma transfusions
- Point of care diagnostic tests include lactate, ketone, cortisol, bile acids, C-reactive protein, biochemistry including magnesium and ammonium, PT & APTT, blood typing.
- · Central line and arterial catheter placement e.g., for direct arterial blood pressure and central venous pressure









Dr Arianne Fabella (Boarded Cardiologist) completed her degree at the University of Sydney, before starting at SASH as a rotating intern in 2018. After this, she pursued a specialty emergency and critical care internship at the University of California, Davis before starting a residency in Cardiology at the University of Georgia. In that time, she developed skills in cardiac interventional procedures and exposure to a number of exotic species. In 2023 she become a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine (Cardiology) before returning to SASH.

Willow, a 3yo MN Netherland Dwarf was rushed to the Emergency Team at SASH North Rvde after his owner noticed he was lethargic with minimal appetite. He was also polydipsic and weak when he was handled. On arrival to SASH he was hyperglycaemic (which is an indicator of marked abdominal pain in rabbits) and anaemic (PCV - 18%). He was treated with fluid therapy and analgesics for a suspected gastrointestinal obstruction and the following day was referred to the Exotics department.

Elevated liver enzymes and worsening anaemia alerted the team to a potential liver lobe torsion, which was then confirmed on abdominal ultrasound along with a significant abdominal effusion. Willow was critically ill and after starting a blood transfusion, he was taken to surgery with the assistance of the skilled anaesthesia and surgery teams. He required inotropic and vasopressor support during his anaesthesia, in addition to ongoing whole

blood transfusion. The offending caudate liver lobe was skilfully removed along with 50ml of haemorrhagic effusion!

Following recovery, Willow was transferred to the Critical Care team for care overnight. The fight was not over however, as Willow developed a pleural effusion and required thoracocentesis 48 hours later. Following this, Willow continued a slow but steady trajectory of improvement and was discharged from hospital 5 days after surgery. He was returned for a revisit and is doing well!

Willow is alive today as a result of the dedication of his owner, the resilience of Willow himself and the collaborative approach of the SASH Emergency, Avian and Exotics, Radiology, Anaesthesia, Surgery and Critical Care teams.


